Chiddingly Parish Council has a policy (permitted by the Local Government Act 1972, Section 137/142) of making grants that contribute to the welfare of the parish community, for example by improving and supporting local facilities. I am contacting you to inform you this process is about to begin for the financial year of 2021-2022.

We are sending the applications invitations out a little earlier this year, in order to give you additional time to complete the form, and in time for the parish council to consider the applications at our parish council meeting October 2020, and prior to us considering our budgeting and precept request for 2021-2022.

I attach the standard application form and a copy of our Grants Policy should you be interested in applying for a grant.

Once again, the parish council will have to decide on the total amount of grants to be offered from the budget for 2021-2022. This means that you may not receive the full amount of grant you applied for depending on the number of other successful applications received.

Finally, I would like to stress the importance of returning the application form before the closing date of 30th September 2020. Applications received after this date may not be considered unless there is still funding available.
