Parish Council Elections May 2019: In a few months the Parish Council is up for re-election. Some members of the current council are standing down and some will be standing again. We will need some new people to put themselves forward. If you think you might be interested please talk to me, Mike Goss, or any member of the council to find out more about being a parish councillor. If more than nine people come forward for the nine seats on the council there will be a contested election and every voter will have a say in who represents your interests.

Nomination forms and guidelines will be available from Wealden District Council in Hailsham early in March, to be completed and returned by the end of the month. Wealden will then publish the list of candidates in April ready for the elections on Thursday 2nd May. Candidates do not have to live within the Parish of Chiddingly, they need only be able to demonstrate a strong connection with the parish. Each candidate will need a proposer and a seconder who must be on the Electoral Roll as a resident of Chiddingly.
