Jubilee Field Verge: The last act of the outgoing council has been completed. The Jubilee verge has been levelled and re-seeded. Temporary posts have been installed to protect the verge until the new grass is established. I ask that everybody keeps cars and other vehicles off the verge until the grass is properly established and the soil settled.
