The Parish Council is the first tier of Local Government representing the local community, delivering services to meet local needs wherever possible. We work closely with many local groups and organisations as well as with Wealden District Council, East Sussex County Council and other agencies.

To qualify for membership of the Council under one of the provisions of S 79 of the Local Government Act 1972, i.e.,

- a) you are on the electoral register for the Parish;*
- b) you have owned or rented land in the Parish for twelve months;*
- c) you have worked in the Parish for twelve months; or*
- d) you have lived in the Parish or within three miles/4.8 kilometres of the Parish boundary for twelve months.*
- e) In addition you should be a qualifying Commonwealth citizen, a citizen of the Republic of Ireland or a citizen of another Member State of the European Community and have attained the age of 18.*
